RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Quiz is open to undergraduate and postgraduate students, from all disciplines, enrolled in a course run by a recognised university in India.
2. The Quiz will be in English.
3. There is no restriction on the number of teams that may participate from a college/university.
4. Each college/university team will consist of two members and both the members should belong to the same college/university.
5. Cross college/university teams are not allowed.

Example A: A team comprising of one student from the School of Law, Christ University and one student from School of Engineering, Christ University, despite being from the same university, will not be allowed to form a team.

Example B: A student pursuing B.A from St. Joseph's College of Arts and Science can team up with another students pursuing B.Sc from St Joseph's College of Arts and Science.

Example C: A student pursuing B.A in English from Hindu College can team up with another pursuing B.A in History from Hindu College.

6. Registrations can be either done online ([here](#)) or by spot registrations at the venue. Online registrations are preferred.
7. A nominal fee of INR 200 per team will be charged which is to be paid at the time of registration.
8. A team is allowed to participate only in the region (see Appendix) in which they are situated. A team which has participated in one region will not be allowed to participate at any other region.



9. Members of the participating team must carry a valid college/university ID card or a bona fide letter from the college/university to present at the time of registration. Teams will not be allowed to participate without furnishing valid IDs of both members.
10. The preliminary rounds will be a written test. On the same day, the top six teams shall go onstage to compete at the regional final.
11. Not more than two teams (teams with the highest scores) from the same college/university shall proceed to the regional final.
12. One of the six spots in each of the regional finals is reserved for the highest scoring team with at least one woman member.
13. Spot and online registration close half an hour before the Quiz starts.
14. Teams which have registered online and who are absent from the venue at the stipulated time, will have to re-register to participate.
15. There can be no change in the composition of the team after registration. Any change would result in the disqualification of the team.
16. A student can participate only as part of one team.
17. In the event of any non-adherence to rules or unfair practices during the Quiz the team concerned shall be disqualified immediately.
18. Students will be responsible for the safety of their property.
19. The rules of the Quiz can be changed by CLPR at any time.
20. All decisions made by CLPR will be final.
