Order: These petitions coming on for orders upon perusing the petitions and the respective affidavits filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.JAYNA KOTHARI, SENIOR COUNSEL FOR MS.DEEKSHITHA GANESAN, Advocate for the petitioner in each of the petitions and of MRS.NARMADHA SAMPATH, Additional Advocate General appearing for the Respondents in all the petitions the court made the following order:-

Heard, M/s. Jayna Kothari, learned Senior Advocate for Ms.Deekshitha Ganesan, appearing for the petitioners and M/s.Narmadha Sampath, learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondents.

- 2. Since an important issue has been raised in these writ petitions in regard to the relaxation of age of the petitioners and the like, which require critical appreciation and examination by this Court and also the fact that the balance of convenience is in favour of the petitioners, the following interim direction is issued.
- (i) There shall be a direction, directing the first respondent to accept the applications from the petitioners for the posts of Grade II Police Constable (AR) under the Notification No.1/2019 dated 06.03.2019 and allow the petitioners to appear in the written examination that is to be conducted by the first respondent for the said post. The interim order passed by this Court is without prejudice to the rights of the parties in these writ petitions.
