Heard Ms. J. Kothari, learned senior counsel, assisted by Swati B. Baruah, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. R.K.D. Choudhury, learned Assistant Solicitor General of India.

The basic challenge of the petitioner is that under the Transgender Persons (Protection of Right) Act, 2019, a National Council for Transgender Persons was to be constituted. The Council has been constituted but the experts who have been made Members of the Council do not have any expertise in the matters relating to transgender communities. It has also been alleged that there is no transparency in the matter of selection of the candidates, who are to be either representatives of the transgender community or experts, in the Council.

Inspite of our repeated opportunities, the Union of India has not filed its counter affidavit.

As a matter of last opportunity, three weeks' and no more is given to Union of India to file its counter affidavit.
