Writ Petitions under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the respective affidavits filed therewith the High Court will be pleased to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus Calling for the records relating to the prospectus for Under Graduate Admission 2019 - 20 issued by the respondent No.1 in so far as it reserves only 5 percent for students from the Vocational Stream for admission to the degree course of Bachelore of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry (B.V.Sc and A.H) in the respondents No.1 and G.O.(D) No.111 dated 12/06/2012 issued by the respondent No.3 and quash the same to the extent that it provides only 5 percent reservation to Vocational Stream candidates and direct the respondent No.1 to enahcne the quota for admission in the B.V.Sc and A.H. degree course for students from the Vocational Stream in WP.No.27498/2019 and ;

(ii) To issue and direct the respondent No.1 to provide at least 1 reserved seat for the Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry (B.V.Sc and A.H) Course for the ST category from the Vocational Stream in any of the colleges of the respondent No.1 and consider the petitioner for the same (in WMP.No.26980/2019) in WP.No.27498/2019 and ;



(iii) To issue an interim order directing the respondent No.1 to admit the petitioner in the ST reserved category in (B.V.Sc and A.H) degree course in any of the Colleges for the academic year 2019 -20 as he as scored the highest rank in ST category from the Vocational Stream and permit him to attend classes for the academic year 2019 -20, pending the hearing and subject to the final (in WMP.No.26982/2019) in WP.No.27498/2019 respectively.

Order : These petitions coming on for orders upon perusing the petitions and the respective affidavits filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of MR.C.PRABHU, Advocate for the petitioner in all the petitions and of MR.E. MANOHARAN, SPECIAL GOVERNMENT PLEADER for 2nd and 3rd Respondents in all the petitions the court made the following order:-

Learned Counsel for the First Respondent seeks time to produce the documents to show the basis on which reservation have been made for the students under vocational stream.

2. Learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the Second and Third Respondents seeks time to file Counter Affidavit.
