His contention is that by a Notification dated 26.09.2020, the percentage reserved for visually hand person having blindness or low vision has been reduced from 2% to 1% State Government. Section 34 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 provides 4% of the reservation. The statute also provides for 1% reservation for blind and low vision and the same has been done by the Notification issued State of Karnataka. The fact remains that the Notification is in consonance with the sign provisions governing the field and therefore, at this stage, question of state Notification issued by the State Government does not arise. Prayer for ginterim relief is declined. The matter has to be heard on merits. Eight weeks time is granted to the respondent-State to file detailed representation. List on 02.12.2021.
