A. The Consultant will work towards the completion of the following tasks related to the ConstitutionofIndia.net website to the satisfaction of the Centre for Law and Policy Research:

- Add to the existing of database of Assembly Member Biographies and Debate Summaries on ConstitutionofIndia.net.
- Curate the digitization of Historical Constitutions and Constituent Assembly's Committee Reports on the website.
- Produce sharp, meaningful and relevant analytical pieces grounded on constitutional and political history for the website.
- Build a rich and exhaustive curriculum for workshops on India's constitutional and political history and 'Constitution in the Classroom' modules on the website.
- Develop and execute these cutting-edge workshops for students of diverse educational backgrounds across the country.
- Examine the scope for other programmes such as talks, seminars etc., to build a vibrant constitutional culture across the country.
- Design, develop and curate relevant content for the website's social media campaigns, posts and videos.

B. Eligibility
